Following consultation, we hereby advertise registration for interest, from academic institutions, in hosting Morph2017.

We hope that the conference builds on from its previous successes, and following consultation we recommend that the conference aims to:

- Be structured as a two/three day conference, held around May 2017, with workshops, presentations and roundtable discussions integrated throughout, focusing on a variety of topics pertaining to the application, analysis, and examination of traditional and geometric morphometric methodologies within archaeological and anthropological analyses;
- Be broken up into distinct sessions, led by external session chairs;
- Continue with the ethos exemplified by the previous two conferences.

We welcome applications from the international community, not just UK-based institutions, as we hope to branch out, create, and strengthen networks overseas.
